### Faith seeking understanding,

Following on from the very well attended lectures before Easter by two members of the School of Theology in DCU, two lecturers from the Loyola Institute of Theology, Trinity College, will speak to us over two Wednesdays. The first lecture on Wednesday, 22<sup>nd</sup> May, is entitled, *The Eucharist: What do we believe?* It will be given by Dr. Fáinche Ryan who is the current Director of the Loyola Institute. Before taking up her post at Trinity she lectured for five years at Mater Dei Institute, DCU, and prior to this was Tutor in Theology at the Margaret Beaufort Institute of Theology, Cambridge, and an affiliated lecturer at the Faculty of Divinity, University of Cambridge.

The second lecture on Wednesday, 29<sup>th</sup> May, is entitled, *The theology of the Book of Kells*, and will be given by Dr. Con Casey. He is the Associate Director of the Loyola Institute. His theological studies have taken him from Galway to Bangalore (India), to Rome and to Oxford. Both sessions are in our parish centre. After the input, there will be an opportunity for questions and conversation, followed by light refreshments. Fr Martin
