Work on Parish Church resumes

We are delighted that the builders have been back working on the church from Monday, 18th May. The internal scaffolding on the left side of the church will be moved to the right side. We are hopeful that all internal scaffolding will be removed before the 20th July, when the church is due to open for public Masses again. The workers will continue working away on the outside east wall and windows (facing Vernon Avenue). The scaffolding on the outside west wall (facing Belgrove Road) is due to come down shortly. It will then be possible to see the results of all the work that has been done on that west side.

Saint Gabriel's church re-opening

Fr Pat McManus returned to the parish of Saint Gabriel's during the week, having spent just over two months cocooning with his cousins in West Cork. If parishioners can be found to clean the church every day, the plan is to open the church for private prayer from tomorrow, Monday, 25th May. Fr Pat also hopes to celebrate Mass behind closed doors at 10.30 am every day, which can be viewed on the church webcam, with the church opening immediately afterwards.
