Work has started on Phase 4, the back area of the church. Our funds only allow us to do the outside work on walls and windows. We will also have to forego Phase 5, the sacristy/



parish office area. We have had to borrow money from our neighbouring parishes. I would like to express my gratitude to Fr. Larry and the Finance Committee of Saint Anthony's parish for an interest free loan of €250,000. We will pay back the capital sum at a rate of €1,000 per month. Saint Gabriel's parish are selling a presbytery, and Fr Pat and his Finance Committee are giving us an interest free loan of €300,000 from the sale, without asking us to pay back the capital sum.
