# Red Wednesday



November is also the month when we mark **Red Wednesday** and our **Week of Witness**. This is a time to put special focus on the fact that some 413 million Christians live in countries where religious freedom is severely violated - that's 18%, or about one in five Christians.

Of these, approximately 220 million live in countries where they are directly exposed to persecution - that's 10%, or one in ten of all Christians.

The Week of Witness runs from **November 16-23**, with Red Wednesday falling this year on **November 19**.
